

Experience a top secret cold war coastal artillery fortress

Built into the rock below Oxelösund in Sweden is a huge nuclear safe bunker, from which 70 soldiers could defend this part of Sweden against an invasion from the Soviet Union and the Warzaw Pact during the cold war.

Guided tours:

The fortress is open with guided one hour tours daily in summer season and weekends during spring and autumn. Groups are welcome all year round.

There is a small café and museum shop with souvenirs and cold war books at the fortress.
